These pot melt pots are hand thrown bisqued clay that is made especially for the process of making pot melts from scrap glass. Since they are hand thrown the sizes will vary slightly. **Minimum order of 3 please**.....otherwise it just isn't worth the time..thanks so much.

The 3-8 inch diameter pots will all come with a standard 6-7 holes.

If you want to have a lot of small holes so that your piece comes out more like a screen melt I will make them especially for you. If you want a single hole or a rectangle hole also let me know..... add \$2.00 to the given price

I cannot guarantee durability or number of uses because of the variability of methods of firing.....I can only tell you that I have used each of my many pots 10 times or so and I have never had one crack. By the wayyou never use kiln wash in your pots.....Wash the dust off them before first use and let dry!!

Note: To Newbies who have never done pot melts....I personally prefer to have a pot for each color combo...i.e. 1. blues , greens, whites.....2. oranges, yellows, whites. Add only a small amount of dark colors as they will overwhelm your lighter colors. I like to have control and not have a random color from a previous melt intermix. Sometimes that can be great if that is what you want though!! Use your own judgment and experience.

These pots can be fired loaded with glass 250 degree-F /hour to whatever you want your top temperature to be...(For 96-COE glass I target 1685 F-degree as top temperature with a 45 minute hold for multiple holes). Let kiln get to room temperature before opening for the sake of the glass and the clay!! Anneal extra on pot melts as you are never 100% sure of the thickness they will come out. Take notes for each load.
